

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE JOHN OF ÁVILA, 450 YEARS LATER: NEW APPROACHES

Baeza (Jaén) 11-13 September 2019

I CIRCULAR

On the occasion of the 450 years of death of St. John of Ávila (1500-1569), the International Conference *John of Ávila, 450 years later: new approaches* will be held in the city of Baeza (Jaén) between the 11th and 13th September 2019. The aim of this initiative is to approach the significance and influence which St. John of Ávila had in the Spanish Modern Age, considering those unprecedented and innovative aspects which have been emphasized in the last years by the research carried out in this field. For this purpose, more than a score of researchers belonging to different Spanish, European and American universities have been convened in order to deal with issues related to the Arts, spirituality, social reforms and ethnic-religious minorities in the activities developed by John of Ávila and, under his influence, by his disciples and followers thorough the 16th and 17th centuries.

The initiative comes from the research group Humanismo Giennense (HUM- 669) and the Chair Andrés de Vandelvira of the University of Jaén, in collaboration with the University of Alcalá. It counts on the sponsorship of the Diputación of Jaén (Institute of Giennensis Studies) and the collaboration of The International University of Andalusia (UNIA) as well as the International Excellence Network *Europa Renascens*.
